James C. Cobey, M.D., MPH

Dr. James Cobey is an orthopedic surgeon specializing in major trauma, spine reconstruction and total joint replacement. As a founding member of Physicians for Human Rights, Dr. Cobey was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1997 for his work in the International Campaign to Ban Landmines, where he developed standardized epidemiological techniques to measure the impact of landmine injuries. Dr. Cobey has also worked on refugee assistance with the UN in the Gaza Strip and developing health programs

in Northern Haiti and western Nigeria. He has just returned from Malawi, where he has been studying surgical capacities for the WHO.
