Dr. Carter is the first African American in U.S. history to be named a Chief Medical Examiner, first female to be named Chief Medical Examiner in the District of Columbia, and the first female to be named as Chief Forensic Pathologist in Indianapolis, Indiana. She was also the Chief Deputy of the Armed Forces Medical Examiner department, was in charge of the military forensic fellowship program, and provided education on forensic pathology to the federal government investigative bodies (FBI, CIA, State Department, OSI, CID and NCIS) on a worldwide basis.
